HISTORY

Adventist youth ministry began in the Lake Union in 1879 when Luther Warren (age 14) and Harry Fenner (age 17) gathered together to pray for youth to be empowered to share the gospel with the world through the “Adventist Missionary Youth Society”.

In 1901, the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists established the **Youth Department**. In 1916, the Lake Union Conference did the same. Youth evangelism began in the Lake Union over 100 years ago, but now it is time for us to **reinvent** how youth/young adults are involved in the mission of the Adventist church.

VISION

To join Youth and Young Adults in the Lake Union Conference to be inspired, trained, and resourced to use their lives to share the good news of the Kingdom of God at their local churches.

MISSION

Matthew 28:19 “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”

HOW TO APPLY FOR EVANGELISM FUNDS

This weekend has been all about **inspiring and motivating you** so that **you** use your God-given talents to make a difference at your local church and community.

Now is the time to present your very own **evangelism project**. The Lake Union Conference will support you with a **\$20,000 Evangelism Fund**. This funding will be in the form of a **dollar for dollar match** between the Lake Union Conference and the local church as funds are available. That means **we can invest up to \$40,000 in evangelism!**
